- **5.** Carding wool
- 6. Washing Wool
- 7. Spinning Wool
- **8.** Dyeing Wool to match desired colors in design
- **9.** Graphing the design
- **10.** Setting up the loom with cotton, wool or silk warp
- **11.** Weaving begins
- **12.** When rug is finished, cut off loom (can be 4 24 months)
- **13.** Washing finished rug
- 14. Lay flat to dry
- **15.** Shearing
- **16.** Finishing the fringes and edges so rug will not unravel
- **17.** Transporting to Market
